

AW36A Newport Circular

Just a short narrative of the hostelries taking part in the centre of Newport.

All routes in Newport begin at the Quay, adjacent to the **Riverside**, where there are refreshments and toilets.

Going under the roadway and following the waters' edge to the other side of the quay (may be via the Quay Arts centre if you would like a cultural diversion), you will come to the **Bargeman's Rest**.

Retracing your steps and then turning right into Sea Street and then left into Holyrood Street, you will pass the **Newport Ale House**. You will also find the **Wrens Nest** on Holyrood Street.

Having sampled these hostelries, continuing to walk into Newport centre away from the quay, crossing the High Street, you will next come to St Thomas' Square. Here you will find the **Wheatsheaf**.

Continue along into Town Lane and where you reach South Street, with the bus station coming into view, you will come upon the **Prince of Wales**.

To complete the Newport hostelries, turn right out of the Prince of Wales along South Street, you will pass TK Maxx and then the Coop. Follow the main route to the right, into St James' Square and at the main traffic lights, turn left into High Street. The main shopping area appears to finish as the road bears left slightly, where the **Castle Inn** can be found on the right hand side. Continue a few yards further along, past Mill Street, where this becomes Carisbrooke Road. The final hostelry here is the **Cask and Crispin**.

Return to the riverside back along the high street and upon reaching the traffic lights at St James' Square, turn left into St James' Street and almost immediately you will find The **Man in the Moon**. Finally, back to the Riverside hub, retrace your steps along the High Street, turning left along Holyrood Street or Quay Street near to the Guildhall.
