

W1704 Godshill to Wroxall.

This particular walk can have muddy sections, even in the Summer months, so I would always recommend stout footwear.

From the Griffin take the lane alongside and immediately follow footpath GL57 at the back of the pub, which goes through very nice woodland. GL57 does appear to split in the woods, try and take a left hand path, but either way, you will eventually come to a more major footpath, GL56. Take a left turn on this path and it will lead you to GL44, which is signposted Stenbury Trail.

Turn right on to Stenbury Trail, passing through the imposing Freemantle Gate. A further 5 mins walking, veer right on to GL47, which will take you past Appuldurcombe Farm, the Falconry Centre and then Appuldurcombe House, which is now a ruin in the care of English Heritage. Walking past the iron railings, carry on along GL47 and past Span Lodge Farm on your right.

Shortly afterwards, coming to Rew Lane, turn left and descend down into Wroxall. As you enter the village in the centre, turn right along the main street where the Star is easily found.
